George Washington & Jefferson National Forest • Virginia • June 21- 28, 2008

The Order of the Arrow and the United States Forest Service have joined together to create a national program titled *ArrowCorps5*. A chance for 5,000 Arrowmen to provide meaningful serve for a week in five different U.S. National Forests across the United States. It will be the largest volunteer service effort ever undertaken by the Boy Scouts of America and Unami Lodge will take part by sending a contingent to the Virginia Arrow Corps 5 Site. Approximate cost will be \$500 per person and an opportunity to earn up to all of your fee will be available. The cost for this once-in-a-lifetime trip for each Arrowman to set an example of leadership in service to those who treasure our national forests will include:

- All Transportation
- Contingent Shirts and patches
- All Accommodations and Most Meals
- Admission to any touring stops (ie Theme Park, Museums, etc.)
- Skills that will help them to be more effective leaders in their lodge, Scout units and communities
- A deeper appreciation of our country's natural resources
- Memories to last a lifetime.

ATTENDANCE

Youth and adult Arrowmen who are registered members of the Cradle of Liberty Council are eligible to participate in *ArrowCorps5*. Participants must meet the Philmont height and weight guidelines listed on the back of this reservation form. Youth members must be at least 14 years of age by June 1, 2008. **All participants must register as a member of the Unami Lodge contingent.**

ABOUT THE PROJECT & SITE

George Washington and Jefferson National Forest were administratively combined in 1995 to form the George Washington and Jefferson National Forest. The two National forests contain nearly 1.8 million acres of public land, representing one of the largest blocks of public land in the eastern United States. The size and the location of the forest make it an excellent center for outdoor activities. The forest covers over 1.8 million acres and 140 miles along the Appalachian Mountains in northwestern Virginia and in eastern West Virginia. Most of the forest is in Virginia and within a day's drive for 54 million people.

Project Area: Allegheny Highlands Trail System and Lake Moomaw.

Project Description: Campsite improvements and construction of seven miles of new multi-user trail north of Covington, VA.

Recreational Opportunities: Whitewater rafting, fishing, mountain biking, and nearby historical sites.
