Readability and National Changes.

The purpose of the below changes is to make the rules and procedures more easily readable and to adhere to national guidelines. Some mentions of Lodge Executive Committee are changed to LEC after the term had already been defined, the condensation of Article III Section 2 Clause C & D into one Clause C, the term Troop Representative has been changed to Unit Representative, requiring the treasurer to give a monthly audit of the lodges finances and the creation of an Appendix F: Chapter Borders.

Article II: Organization

<u>Section 4</u>: The lodge shall consist of chapters, the borders of which shall be determined by the <u>lodge executive committee</u> **LEC**, **as shown in Appendix F**.

Article III: Membership

Section 2: Election to Membership

Clause C: A Boy Scout troop may request one election at any point during the lodge operating year. This clause shall remain effective through January 31, 2019.

Clause D: A Scout troop, Venturing crew, or Sea Scout ship may request one election at any point during the lodge operating year. This clause shall become effective February 1, 2019.

Clause C: A Boy Scouts of America troop, ship or crew may request one election at any point during the lodge operating year.

Article IV: The Lodge Executive Committee

<u>Section 4</u>: The LEC shall carry out the operations of the lodge through the use of operating committees. Each operating committee shall have a chair who shall be a voting member of the LEC.

Clause A: The lodge operating committees shall be:

- 1) American Indian Affairs
- 2) Brotherhood

- 3) Camp Promotions
- 4) Ceremonies
- 5) Communications
- 6) Events
- 7) History
- 8) Leadership Development
- 9) Lodge Operations
- 10) Membership
- 11) OA Troop Unit Representative
- 12) Ordeal
- 13) Service
- 14) Unit Elections
- 15) Vigil Honor

Clause B: The lodge chief, with the approval of the lodge adviser, may create ad hoc committees to fulfill a special function or task as necessary. The chair of any ad hoc committee shall be a voting member of the LEC. When the need for these ad hoc committees has passed, the lodge executive committee LEC may vote to remove them by proposal of the lodge chief.

Article VII: Finance

<u>Section 2</u>: In January, the lodge treasurer shall submit for approval by the LEC an annual budget for the current lodge year.


Clause B: The treasurer shall submit a monthly audit of the lodge's balances either in person or via email.
